TWO PROGRAMS AVAILABLE

KINDER CAMP: Children entering kindergarten. This is a full day on-campus program (8:30 a.m.-3:00 p.m.). Includes lessons, movie, cookout, sports, indoor music, and movement activities. Monday-Friday. Fee: \$150.00/week.

YOUTH CAMP: Children entering 1st-6th grades. This is a full-day program (8:30 a.m.-3:00 p.m.). Includes academic classes in the morning and field trip activities in the afternoon. Monday-Friday. Fee: \$195.00/week.
