Eddie Shannon, Basketball, PBAU

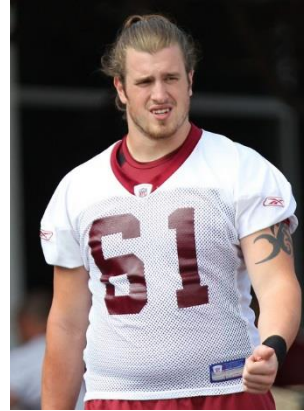
Coach Shannon is no stranger to Palm Beach County, having played at Cardinal Newman High School in West Palm Beach before moving on to a promising academic career at the University of Florida. He was twice named the Palm Beach Post Player of the Year and was a three-time Sun-Sentinel Player of the Year while garnering Class 3A State Player of the Year honors in 1994 and 1995.

While suiting up for Coach Kruger and Coach Donovan with the Gators (1995-99), Shannon helped lead his team to a Sweet 16 finish at the NCAA Division I men's basketball tournament as a senior while being named the recipient of the Frontier Communications Most Courageous Award from the NCAA. Twice named to the Southeastern Conference's All-SEC team, Shannon would go on to earn many accolades at the professional level as well. Playing mostly in the Euro League, Shannon played professionally in countries such as France, Italy, Latvia, Russia and Sweden. He was named the 2002 Swedish League Guard of the Year and Finals MVP while tallying the league's scoring championship. His play in the Russian Superleague a year later produced another scoring title while being named to the All-Russia first-team. Shannon has also been recognized for his work within the community including recognition from the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners for directing summer programs to help kids learn and improve their basketball skills. Coach McMahon has over 20 years of collegiate coaching and playing experience with a resume that includes coaching stints at Belhaven (Miss.) University and Greenville (Ill.) College. McMahon spent the past two seasons leading Belhaven to back-to-back appearances in the NAIA National Tournament, reaching at least the Elite 8 in both campaigns. His first season was a memorable one as he helped guide the Blazers to their second-ever NAIA National Championship as his team finished 19-4-1 and defeated the University of Mobile 2-0 in the title match. Coach Jesse Vanatta started his lacrosse career in Washington, DC and continued at the collegiate level at Palm Beach Atlantic University, where he earned All-Conference honors as a midfielder. As four year starter and two-year captain, Jesse led his team to the SELC conference championship tournament three years in a row. In his first year serving on the coaching staff at PBAU as the defensive coordinator, the Sailfish made their first ever appearance to the national tournament and earned a national ranking as high as sixth in the country. He also coaches for Loggerhead Lacrosse, a local youth travel team, in the U15 division.
